The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside still waters; he restores my soul.

He leads me in right paths for his name's sake.

Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no evil; for you are with me; your rod and your staffthey comfort me.

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life,

First Reading Isaiah 45:9-22 Reader **Richard Adams**

Woe to you who strive with your Maker, earthen vessels with the potter! Does the clay say to the one who fashions it, 'What are you

making? or 'Your work has no handles'?

Woe to anyone who says to a father, 'What are you begetting?' or to a woman, 'With what are you in labour?'

Thus says the Lord,

the Holy One of Israel, and its Maker: Will you question me about my children,

or command me concerning the work of my hands? I made the earth,

- and created humankind upon it; it was my hands that stretched out the heavens,
- and I commanded all their host. I have aroused Cyrus in righteousness,
- and I will make all his paths straight;

he shall build my city

and set my exiles free, not for price or reward,

says the Lord of hosts.

Thus says the Lord:

The wealth of Egypt and the merchandise of Ethiopia, and the Sabeans, tall of stature,

shall come over to you and be yours, they shall follow you;

they shall come over in chains and bow down to you.

They will make supplication to you, saying, 'God is with you alone, and there is no other; there is no god besides him.'

Truly, you are a God who hides himself,

O God of Israel, the Saviour.

All of them are put to shame and confounded, the makers of idols go in confusion together.

But Israel is saved by the Lord

with everlasting salvation;

you shall not be put to shame or confounded to all eternity.

For thus says the Lord,

who created the heavens

(he is God!),

who formed the earth and made it (he established it;

he did not create it a chaos,

- he formed it to be inhabited!):
- I am the Lord, and there is no other.

I did not speak in secret, in a land of darkness;

- I did not say to the offspring of Jacob, 'Seek me in chaos.'
- I the Lord speak the truth, I declare what is right.

Assemble vourselves and come together. draw near, you survivors of the nations! They have no knowledgethose who carry about their wooden idols, and keep on praying to a god that cannot save. Declare and present your case; let them take counsel together! Who told this long ago? Who declared it of old? Was it not I, the Lord? There is no other god besides me, a righteous God and a Saviour; there is no one besides me.

Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.

Second Reading Revelation 14:1-3,5 Reader Jeremy Cumaraswamy

Then I looked, and there was the Lamb, standing on Mount Zion! And with him were one hundred and forty-four thousand who had his name and his Father's name written on their foreheads. And I heard a voice from heaven like the sound of many waters and like the sound of loud thunder; the voice I heard was like the sound of harpists playing on their harps, and they sing a new song before the throne and before the four living creatures and before the elders. No one could learn that song except the one hundred forty-four thousand who have been redeemed from the earth. They have been redeemed from humankind as first fruits for God and the Lamb, and in their mouth no lie was found; they are blameless.
